Whereas I Thomas Hurley of the City of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania Paper Hanger in and by a certain Obligation bearing even Date herewith do stand bound unto "The Library Company of Philadelphia" in the Sum of Five Thousand Dollars lawful Silver Money of the United States of America conditioned for the Payment of the just Sum of Two Thousand five hundred Dollars such as above-said together with lawful Interest for the same in Way and Manner therein expressed These are to desire and authorise you or any of you to appear for Me in the said Court or elsewhere in an Action of Debt there or elsewhere brought or to be brought against Me at the Suit of "The Library Company of Philadelphia" aforesaid their Successors or Assigns on the said Obligation as of the last next or any other subsequent Term there or elsewhere to be held and confess Judgment thereupon against Me for the Sum of Five Thousand Dollars such as above-said Debt besides Costs of Suit by Cognovit Actionem or otherwise as to you shall seem meet and for your or any of your so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant And I do hereby for myself my ~~Heirs~~ Executors and Administrators remise release and forever quit claim unto "The Library Company of Philadelphia" aforesaid their Successors and Assigns all and all Manner of Error and Error Misprisions Misentries Defects and Imperfections whatever in the entering of the said Judgment or any Process or Proceedings thereon or thereto or any wise touching or concerning the same In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the Eighteenth Day of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twelve.
