Whereas "The Library Company of Philadelphia" hereinafter
called the Obligors] in and by a certain Obligation bearing even date
herewith do stand bound unto John Livezey of the City of Philadelphia
Gentleman [hereinafter called the Oblige] in the sum of Six thousand six hun-
dred and sixty six dollars and sixty eight cents lawful money of the
United States of America, conditioned for the payment of the just sum
of Three thousand three hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty four
cents upon the termination of the natural life of Sarah M. Livezey Wife of
the said John Livezey, to the said John Livezey if he shall then be liv-
ing and if he be dead to his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, to-
gether with interest thereon payable half yearly at the rate of Six per
cent per annum to the said John Livezey during the life of his said
Wife, and if his said Wife shall survive him then during her life to her
and after her decease together with the principal debt thereby secured to
the Executors, Administrators or Assigns of the said John Livezey, and
together with the payment of all and every sum or sums as should thereafter
be assessed by any public authority [except any income tax] upon the said
principal debt or sum or upon the interest thereof when and as the same
would otherwise be payable by the said Oblige, it being the same debt or prin-
cipal sum which by an Indenture of Mortgage of even date therewith made
between the said Obligors and Oblige to which an Internal Revenue Stamp of
the United States of the denomination of three dollars and fifty cents had been
previously affixed is secured upon All that certain Lot or Piece of Ground
composed of four smaller Lots of Ground, Situate in the Eighth Ward of the
City of Philadelphia aforesaid. Beginning at a point on the West side of
Juniper street at the distance of One hundred and thirty three feet six in-
ches or thereabouts Southward from the South side of Walnut street as in the said
Indenture is particularly described. Provided however, and it is hereby express-
ly agreed that if at any time default shall be made in the payment of the
aforesaid interest for the space of thirty days after any half yearly pay-
ment thereof shall fall due or any sum assessed as aforesaid for like a
space of time after demand therefor, then and in such case the whole prin-
cipal debt aforesaid shall at the option of the said Oblige his Executors, Ad-
ministrators or Assigns become due and payable immediately and the payment
