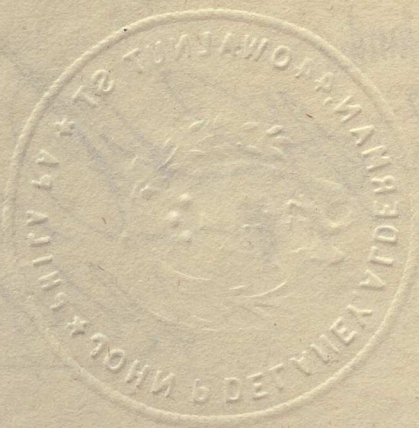


On the First day of March Anno Domini 1870 Before me the Subscriber an Alderman in and for the City of Philadelphia personally appeared the within named Sarah M. Livezey wife of the within named John Livezey and in due form of Law acknowledged the within written Indenture, to be her act and deed and desired the same to be Recorded as such. She said Sarah M. Livezey being of full age, separate and apart from her said husband by me examined and the full contents of the said within written Indenture being by me first made known unto her, did thereupon declare and say that she did voluntarily and of her own free will and accord sign, Seal and as her act and deed deliver the said Indenture without any coercion or compulsion of her said husband.
