Smiths Laws 1807 page 392.

By referring to Smiths Laws 1787 page 406. note the following may be found "Supplement to the Act of 6th of April 1790 - passed 13. April 1791 (chap. 1562) All Gunpowder brought into the City after the 1st of July (then next) shall be deposited and kept in the new magazine (on the banks of the Schuylkill, on the North side of Walnut Street.

The said Commissioners caused the said lots or pieces of land to be subdivided into convenient Building lots, and in a Plan thereof numbered the same from Nos 1 to 48 inclusive and laid open certain Streets for the accomodation thereof
