Hutchinson his true and lawful Attorney for him and in his name and behalf to execute acknowledge and deliver and deed or Agreement, certificate declaration or other paper or instrument of writing that might be necessary or proper to express or give evidence of his said consent or approbation in the case of any sale or sales which may be made of said Real Estate or any part thereof by said Executor or Executors, Trustee or Trustees as fully and with like effect as he might have done if personally present.
