My dear Sir

I have your note with the accompanying Certificates and Powers of Attorney. There are only two of the Stocks — the Harrisburgh W^t. Joy R^r, and Union Mutual Ins^o that can be sold the others are practically worthless, and two if not more of the Corporations are out of existence, so that transfer in their case will be impossible. To effect transfer where it is possible, the Certificate of the Register of Wills that Mr Williams is the Executor of Dr Rush is necessary, and a separate Certificate.
