



In the Court of Common Pleas for the City and County of Philadelphia

In the matter of the application of the Library Company of Philadelphia for Amendment to their Charter presented the 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 1873.

And now, to wit, December 1<sup>st</sup> 1873 due proof having<sup>been</sup> exhibited of the publication of notice of said application agreeably to the order of the Court, and the Court being of opinion that the objects and conditions of the said amendment are lawful and beneficial; and no cause to the contrary being shewn the Court do decree and declare that the said amendment shall be deemed and taken to be a part of the instrument upon which the said the Library Company of Philadelphia was formed and established to all intents and purposes as if the same had originally been made part thereof and it is further ordered that the said amendment be recorded in the office for recording deeds &c.
