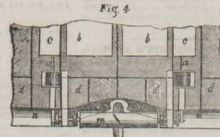
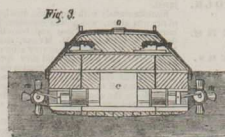
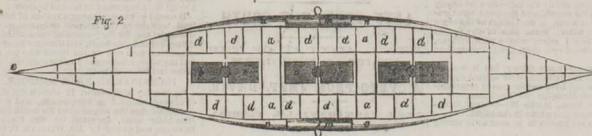
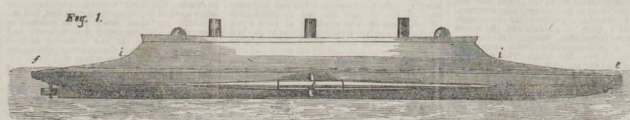


THE RENWICK STEAM BATTERING RAM. HER CAPACITY, SPEED, AND ARMAMENT.



The Renwick Steam Battering Ram.
Above we give sketches of the Steam Battering Ram projected by Mr. R. S. Rawlins, of New York, and which is of the following dimensions—
Length of vessel.....400 feet.
Breadth of beam.....60 feet.
Depth of hold.....37 feet.
Draught of water.....22½ feet.
Speed per hour at least.....18 miles.
Figure 1 represents a side view of the vessel;
Figure 2 a plan of it at the lower edge of the
armour plates, four feet below the water line;
Figure 3 a transverse section at the engines, and
Figure 4 a plan of a fragment of the vessel at the engines.
