

good Judgement shall from time to time be recommended from their own knowledge or by the advice of the said Trustees shall be named and pitched upon, and the remaining forty shillings sterling to apply & pay for duly sweeping the Room and keeping the Books clean from dust, for which end they shall at least once in every year be taken down & dusted. Provided nevertheless if any repairs shall be wanted in mending the Windows or by other accidents, as such may happen or more particularly any great damage for repairing of which the whole rents except the forty shillings per annum shall be appropriated. And upon this further Trust and Confidence that on the decease of the said William Logan, or other determination of his said Office, they the said Trustees and they who by descent or otherwise shall succeed them in the said Trust do permit and suffer the eldest son living of the said William Logan and the Heirs male of the said son lawfully issuing to occupy and hold the said office of Librarian as aforesaid, Under the direction of the said Trustees, and to receive the Rents Issues and profits of the premises therein before granted in the same manner and to the same purposes as therein is before expressed in relation to his or their ancestor the first Librarian therein before named during their respective lives if they shall respectively behave themselves well therein. And in default of ^{the} said eldest son then in like manner to the second, third and every other son of the said William Logan successively in remainder the one after the other as they shall be in priority of Birth and seniority of age and to the several and respective Heirs male of the body and bodies of every such second third and other son and sons in succession ever preferring the elder through every generation in manner & form aforesaid if duly accomplished. But in case of the failure of all such male issue of the said William Logan, that then the said Trustees and those who by descent or otherwise shall succeed them in the said Trust do permit and suffer James Logan (party to these presents) the younger son of the said Testator if then living to succeed as Librarian in manner aforesaid and to receive the rents issues & profits aforesaid of the hereby granted premises, if he shall well behave himself in the said Office, and dispose thereof in the manner before directed in the case of his elder Brother. And on this further Trust and Confidence that on the decease of the said James Logan the younger, they the said Trustees and those who by descent or otherwise shall succeed in the said Trust, do suffer and permit the eldest son of the said James Logan the younger, if he shall live to marry, and have any, and the heirs male of the body of such first son lawfully issuing to take occupy and hold the said Office of Librarian and to receive the Rents issues and profits of the premises therein before granted and to dispose of the same in the manner aforesaid during their respective lives if they shall respectively behave themselves well therein. And for default of such Issue then in the same manner shall permit the second and third and every other son of the said James Logan the younger successively and in remainder the one after the other as they shall be in priority of Birth and seniority in age and to the several and respective heirs male of the Body and Bodies of every such son and sons in Manner & form aforesaid, And in case of the failure of all such Issue male by the said William Logan and James Logan (the son) Under this further Trust and confidence that the said Trustees and those who
