

of the Testator to prevent which difficulty as much as is in the power of the parties hereto, it is agreed that the Librarian for the time being shall in a place or places appropriated for that purpose in the ^{said} folio bound Book enter the names, days of birth, days of marriage and to whom, and days of death of all the descendants of the Testator from time to time as they happen, with such precision by giving a number to each descendant and giving the numbers of the Parents as well as the names, that there may be no room left for mistake of the whole descent of each (which by the similarity of names there would be without numbers) at least of all those who shall dwell in the City and County of Philadelphia and of all others when they come to his knowledge. And it is agreed that this present Indenture after it is recorded and entered in the said folio Book and all other writings herein recited or mentioned shall be carefully kept in a Book or Drawer in the said Library under two Locks whereof the key of one to be kept by the Librarian and the key of the other Lock by the senior Trustee for the time being or such other of them as the majority of them shall direct. And it is agreed that if the Legislature of Pennsylvania for the time being shall be informed of or suspect any breach or breaches of the Trusts by the Testator intended to be reposed in the Trustees or Librarians for the time being or of the Rules by virtue of these presents agreed on to be agreed on then and in that case the said Legislature are hereby beseeched and prayed by themselves or a Committee to visit the said Library from time to time and to enquire into such breaches of Trust & Rules and to apply proper remedies and to make further Rules and Regulations for preventing the like breaches for the time to come, consistent with the intention of the Testator. And it is hereby further mutually declared & agreed by all the parties hereto for themselves severally and respectively and for their several and respective heirs only and not jointly or the one of them for the other of them or for the act or default or heirs of the other or others of them in manner and form following that is to say, That in order to maintain a perpetual succession of seven Trustees for the uses aforesaid from time to time when and as often as any of the said Trustees parties to these presents or their Successors shall depart this life so often from time to time the survivors of them the said Trustees shall within thirty days next after the death of such Trustee or Trustees meet at the said Library or some other suitable place according to the notice for that purpose to be given to each surviving Trustee by the Librarian, and such surviving Trustees or the major part of them so met shall elect and chuse some fit and capable Person or Persons in the place & stead of the deceased, and immediately upon such election, a memorandum thereof and of the name or names of the new elected Trustee or Trustees shall be regularly and fairly entered in the said folio Book and signed by the Electors or the major part of them and the new Trustee or Trustees so elected and chosen shall have the same power and authority respecting the trust aforesaid as any of the surviving Trustees or the parties to these presents can or may have by virtue hereof; regard in the said election being always had to the family and descendants of the said Testator so that if the deceased Trustee or Trustees shall have been the descendant or descendants of the said Testator the Trustee or Trustees to be elected in succession as aforesaid shall also be the descendant or descendants or nearest of the male kin of the said Testator if any such can be found duly qualified for the Trusts aforesaid, and if such descendant or next of kin be
