



Daguer town 24th Decr 1827

Dear Sir

Your two letters were duly received - the last by yesterday's mail. As soon as I received the first I made out in writing a request to the Commissioners that they would direct a search and such a certificate as you wished to be made - The board being in session at the time, I handed it to them. They said it should be attended to at their first leisure but that as the Court was sitting they should be unable to attend to it for a few days. I called afterwards upon their clerk and he promised to attend it as soon as he possibly could. I saw him a second time and urged his attention to it & he again promised - but they adjourned till next Friday without my hearing from them. The truth is that the business is in some confusion at the board - a new clerk (who, generally, is the factotum of the Court office) has just been chosen and has not yet become master of the business. I expect, indeed, that when he gets to work at your business it will be a matter of some
