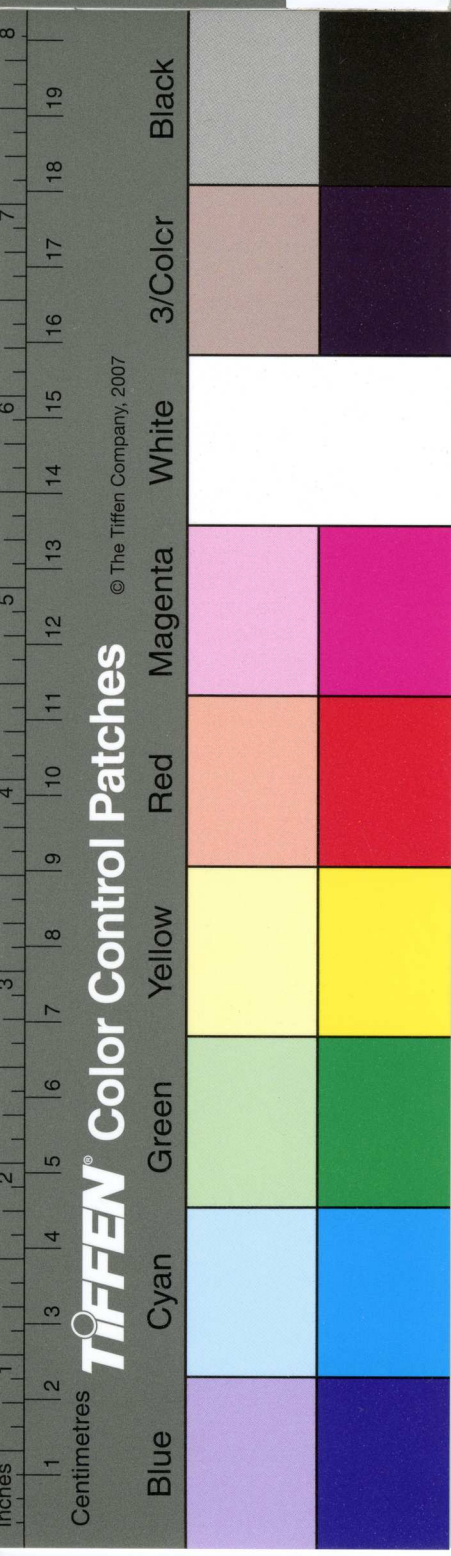




To All to whom these presents shall come
