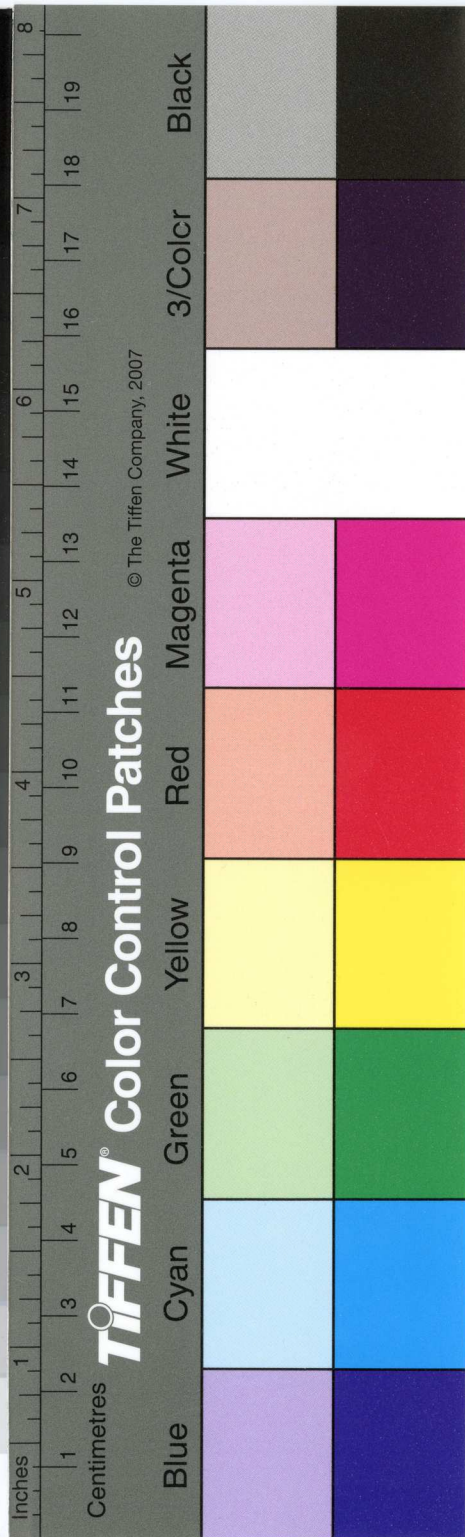




Your Com: of course did not in any way
