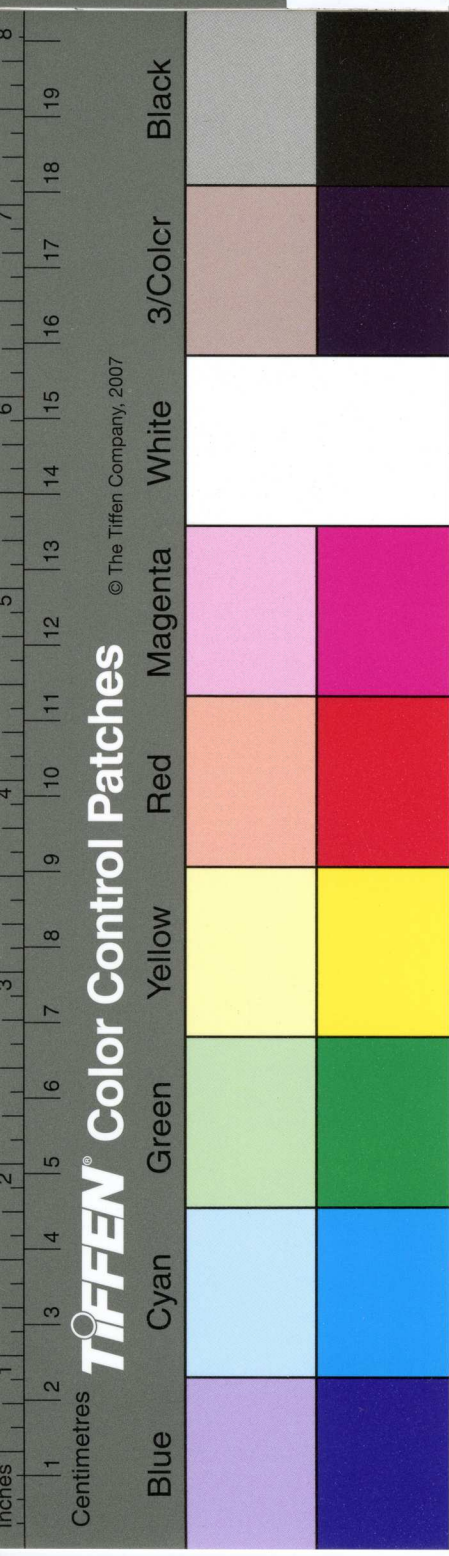
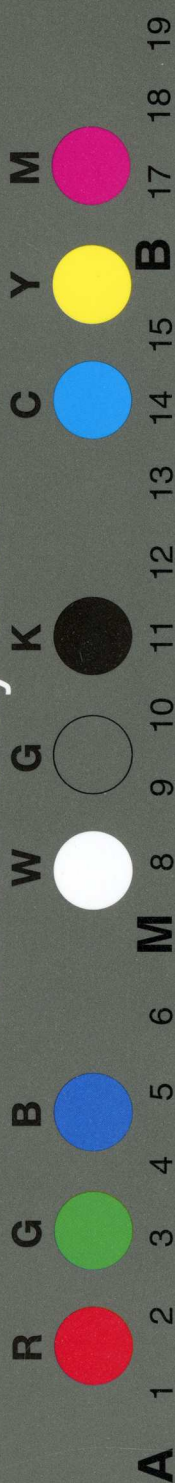




To all to whom these presents shall come,

 and sixty one, intended to be recorded, executed by the Library Company
 of Philadelphia, in Trust for the Loganian Library, and Elias
 Paxson, Charles Smith, Mordecai Pearson, Levi Black, Thomas
 Thornton, Mahlon Atkinson, Joseph Seaker, Mahlon Gibbs,
 Oliver Paxson, Reuben Naylor, James Wreden, John Coates, Thomas
 S. Smith, Josiah B. Smith by his attorney in fact Joseph H. Weston
 duly constituted and appointed by power of attorney bearing date the
 day of Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred
 and sixty one, Elias Eastburn and Timothy Eastburn by their Guardian
 Josias Eastburn, and the Sahaska and New Hope Turnpike road
 Company, We were chosen to make a valuation of the fair market
 value of the fee simple of a certain tract of land in the townships
