

descendants of said James Logan, the Testator, if any such be found duly qualified to officiate in said office & supply the place of said Infant until he become of age. Unless said Infant by the Pregnancy of his parts shall by the said Trustees be judged capable before that time to officiate in office and supply said place, in which case he shall enter.

And if it should so happen that no one of the Testators, descendants shall be found so qualified in literature that he shall understand and be capable of expounding all the Roman Classics & understands the new Greek Testament in the original, with Homers and Hesiods poems in the original. Then the said Testator recommends to his Trustees to appoint such proficient in literature without hesitation if he be of a sober life & conversation, to be the Librarian.

The Trustees are desired to meet at least twice a year once about the Month of March, & once in September or oftener as there may be occasion especially for appointing Librarian as also for enquiring into his conduct.

And under the further trust that the said Librarian or his sufficient deputy shall give due attendance on Saturday of every week, from the 3^d hour to the seventh hour in the afternoon in summer and so long as one can see in winter.

To the end that all persons residing in this province, who have been educated, in reading & writing, and more especially those who have any knowledge in the Latin tongue, or who study any of the Mathematical sciences, or Medicine, and by the Librarians favor any other person, may have free admittance on the days aforesaid or any other day on which the Librarian may be prevailed to attend, with liberty if desired of borrowing any of said books, provided always that such person give his note to the Librarian acknowledging the receipt of the book borrowed,
