

whatsoever and it is agreed that the same shall be recorded in the office of Recorder of Deeds in Philadelphia & be fairly copied into a Folio Book to be kept for that and other purposes in the Library.

And whereas some ages hence it may be difficult to know who are entitled to be Trustees & Librarians within the intent and purpose of the Founder, to prevent such difficulty as much as in the power of the parties hereto, it is agreed that the Librarian for the time being shall in a place or places appropriated for the purpose in said Folio Book enter the names days of Birth & Marriage and to whom & days of death of all the Descendants of the Founder from time to time, as they happen with such precision by giving a number to each descendant and numbers of the Parents, as well as name, that there may be no room left for mistake of the whole descent of each.

At least of all those who shall dwell in the City & County of Philadelphia and of all others, when it shall come to his knowledge.

And it is further agreed if the Legislature of Pennsylvania for the time being be informed of or suspect any breach or breaches of the Trusts by the Founder intended to be reposed in the Trustees or Librarian for the time being or of the rules by virtue of these presents agreed on or to be agreed on, then the said Legislature are beseeched & prayed by themselves or a committee to visit said Library from time to time and inquire into such breaches of Trust & Rules and apply proper remedies & make further rules and regulations for preventing like breaches for time to come.

And it is hereby further agreed that in order to maintain a perpetual succession of Seven Trustees for the uses aforesaid from time to time, when and as often as any of the aforesaid Trustees shall depart this life so often the survivors shall
