



W HEREAS a CHARTER, under the great Seal of the Province of Pennsylvania, bearing Date the 6th Day of October, *Anno Domini* 1759, was granted by the Honourable WILLIAM DENNY, Esquire, to THE UNION LIBRARY COMPANY OF PHILADELPHIA, incorporating them into one Body Politick; AND WHEREAS a *Law* was enacted by the said Company, the 30th Day of January, 1769, for the *Admission* of THE MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION LIBRARY: THESE ARE THEREFORE TO CERTIFY, That *Lebuloon Rudolph* of the City of *Philad. Merch.* for and in Consideration of his *Share and Property* in the Books and *Effects* of the said ASSOCIATION LIBRARY, delivered unto the DIRECTORS of the said UNION LIBRARY COMPANY, and also the Sum of *Twenty Shillings*, paid into the Hands of *James Whiteall* the said Company's TREASURER, as  $\text{p}^{\text{r}}$  Receipt hereto appears, agreeable to the above-mentioned Law, IS HEREBY admitted a *Member* of THE UNION LIBRARY COMPANY OF PHILADELPHIA, and entitled for himself, his heirs, and Assigns, to hold, possess, and enjoy, forever, *One equal Share* in the Estate, Books, and Effects of the said Company, Under the Restrictions and Reservations of the said Charter, and *Conformable* to the Laws and Ordinances of the said Company. IN WITNESS WHEREOF the said DIRECTORS have caused the *Seal* of the said Company to be hereunto affixed, this *Seventeenth Day of February* — *One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty-Nine.*
