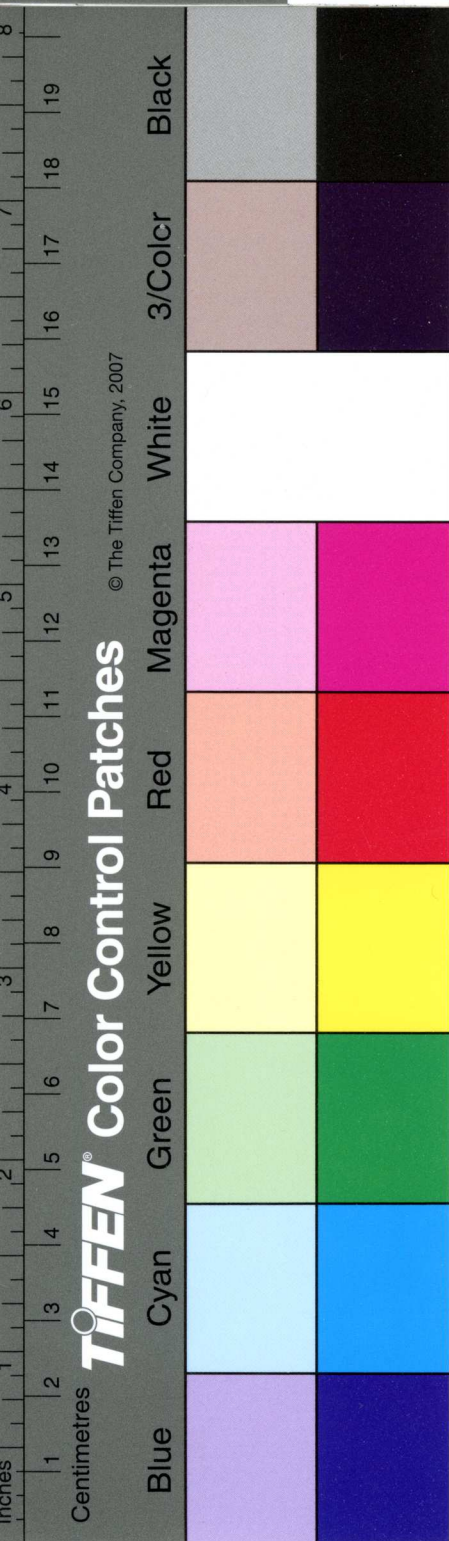




a book from the Philadelphia Library upon the same share; and Provided also that such pledge shall not be received as a sufficient security for any book, that shall be considered by the Librarian as of greater value by itself than Twenty dollars.

2. The promissory note & pledge shall be in the following form:—

"I promise to pay to the Trustees of the Loggeman Library or order the sum of Forty dollars specie on demand, for value received; and for the due payment thereof I hereby pledge a share in the Library Company of Philadelphia standing in my name, and authorize the Directors of the said Company to transfer the same to the said Trustees, if I make default in said payment. Nevertheless if agreeably to the Rules to be observed in the use of the Books belonging to the said Loggeman Library, I return undamaged to their Librarian a Book entitled
