

Two Parades by the Soldiers and Sailors,

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 2D, 1868.

The line will be formed at 9 o'clock, in the following order: 1st Division, Phila. Boys in Blue; 2d Division, Pennsylvania delegations; 3d Division, New York delegations; 4th Division, New Jersey delegations; 5th Division, delegations from Eastern States; 6th Division, Delaware, Maryland and Virginia delegations; 7th and 8th Divisions, Western, Southern and Southwestern States; 9th Division, crippled Veterans in ambulances.

THE ROUTE:

The line will move at 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ A. M., precisely, over the following route: Down Broad to Spring Garden, down Spring Garden to Twelfth, down Twelfth to Arch, out Arch to Twenty-first, down Twenty-first to Walnut, down Walnut to Broad, up Broad to Chestnut, down Chestnut to Third, down Third to Walnut, up Walnut to Fourth, down Fourth to Pine, up Pine to Twelfth, up Twelfth to Walnut, out Walnut to Broad, at which point the delegation will dismiss, moving southward.



The line for the Torchlight Procession will be formed at 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ P. M., when the above delegations will be joined by the Republican Invincibles, Ward Grant & Colfax Clubs, Berry Campaign Club, German Campaign Club, Campaign Club of 1860 and 1868.

The Procession will move at 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ P. M., precisely, over the following route: Up Broad to Christian, down Christian to Third, up Third to Girard Avenue, up Girard Avenue to Broad Street, down Broad Street to League House, countermarch to Chestnut Street, down Chestnut to Third, and dismiss.
