




only when the books were in ^{process} of restoration that the dilapidation resulting from the long ^{period} of time that had elapsed since they had special attention paid to them. became plainly apparent, for it was not only the backs, but the sides, the corners, the linings, and in many cases the title pages, and the end sheets that required repairing. and there were volumes that had been so badly injured that it required the utmost care and skill to save them to the Library for future use. Then the numerous maps and charts, with the cases needed for their protection, needed more care than any one would have anticipated from a cursory examination. No expert, no matter how experienced could have formed even an approximation to a correct estimate of the cost of restoration. If such an estimate had been made the binder would have been compelled to restrict his labour to the amount of compensation agreed upon, and disregarded the actual condition of the books, to their permanent injury, and to the lasting dissatisfaction of all who feel an interest
