
Hathaway's Portable Writing Case, Designed for Army use.

A small metal case contains Inkstand, Pens, Pencils, Envelopes, &c., — attached to this is a Portfolio for Note Paper and Letters,— and connected with the whole is a light, yet strong Hinge Table or Writing Board, which can be held in the hand and used in any position, either standing, sitting, or on horseback, and furnishes a hard and smooth surface for writing, always at hand and easily used.

The whole forms a roll of nine inches long and two-and-a-quarter inches in diameter, and, when filled with Stationery, weighs only thirteen ounces, and can be carried in the knapsack.
