



CASH RECEIVED PREVIOUSLY TO THE OPENING OF THE FAIR.

The Treasurers of the different Committees will take care of all cash that comes into their hands previously to the opening of the Fair, and are recommended to open special bank accounts for its safe keeping.

Immediately on the opening of the Fair, a sub-Committee of two, appointed by the Finance Committee, will take charge of the funds then in hand, and receivable thereafter; and Regulations for the daily government of all who have control of the receipts of the separate Tables or Departments at the Fair Grounds, will be printed and handed to them on or before the day of opening.
