LIBRARY COMPANY.

A LAW directing the Manner of admitting new Members.

T IS ENACTED by the LIBRARY COMPANY of Philadelphia, That no Perfon who shall hereafter become possessed of a Share in the Books and Effects of the faid Company, shall be thereby entitled to a Vote in any of their Affairs, or be deemed a Member, without first being approved of by the None to be ad-Directors for the Time being; nor shall any mitted, with-Person, other than the Heirs, Executors, or out being first approved, &c. Affigns of a Member of the faid Company, be entitled to a Share in the Books, Estate and Effects of the faid Company, without paying into the Hands of the faid Company's Treasurer, so much Money as in the Judgment of the faid Directors a Share shall then be worth.

AND IT IS FURTHER ENACTED, That upon Approbation of the Directors, and Payment of the faid Money, the Party paying
