and Four Pamphlets, provided they have been in the Library at least Twelve Months.

XI. EVERY Saturday Evening, before the Library is shut up, the Librarian shall examine his Book of Entries, and make out a List of the Forseitures which have arisen that Week, in a Book to be kept for that Purpose; and, on the Second Monday in every Month, he shall, from that List, deliver to the Secretary a Copy of all the Forseitures incurred the preceding Month, to be laid before the Directors, at their usual Meetings.
