Lands, &c.

Power to hold in Law, TO HAVE, HOLD, RECEIVE, AND ENTOY Lands, Tenements, Rents, Liberties, Franchises, and Hereditaments, in Fee-simple, or for Term of Life, Lives, Years, or otherwise; and also Goods, Chattels, and other Things, of what Nature, Kind or Quality, foever. AND ALso to Give, Grant, Lett, Sell, or Affign, the same Lands, Tenements, Hereditaments, Goods and Chattels; and to do and execute all other Things about the same, by the Name aforesaid: AND ALso, that they and their Successors, by the Name of The Library Company of Philadelphia, be, and shall be, for ever hereafter. Persons able and capable in Law, to Power to fue, fue and be fued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, defend and be defended, in all or any of the Courts, or other Places, and before any Judges, Justices, and other Persons whatsoever, in all Manner of Actions, Suits, Complaints, Pleas, Causes and Matters, whatsoever, and of what Nature or Kind soever. AND that it shall and may be lawful, to and for the faid Library Company of Philadelphia, and their Successors, for ever hereafter, to have one common Seal for their Use, in their Affairs; and the fame at their Will and Pleasure to change and alter. AND for the well Governing and Ordering the Affairs of the faid Company, We do, for Us, Our Heirs, and Successors, further Power to meet Grant, That it shall and may be lawful for the faid Company, and their Succesfors, to assemble and meet together on the

first Monday in May in every Year, and

To have a common Seal.
