RULES.

I. All persons are allowed to consult the books in the room without charge during Library hours.

II. The Librarian shall attend at the Library every day (Sunday excepted) from half-past eight o'clock A. M. until six o'clock P. M. He shall enter in the catalogue kept at the Library, such books as may be purchased or added to the Library; label and number the same, as well as all others from which the label or number may be torn off or defaced.
