*A Law for ascertaining the fines for neglecting  
the yearly payments.*

**W**HEREAS by a law of the Library Company of Philadelphia, entitled, "A Law for ascertaining the fines for neglecting the yearly payments," it is, amongst other things, enacted, "That if any member or members of the said company shall neglect to pay his or their yearly payments, for any time not exceeding three months, from and after the first Monday in May, that he or they shall pay the sum of *Five Shillings* as a fine, together with the said *Ten Shillings*;" which said law has been found inconvenient and too strict:
