Case where a Proviso cometh
alone; and so it is if a Man by
Indenture letteth Lands for
Years, provided always, and
it is covenanted and agreed
between the said Parties,
That the Lessee shoulde not
alien: And it was adjudged
that this was a Condition by
Force of the Proviso, and a Co-
venant by Force of the other
Words.

This Word Proviso shall be
also taken as a Limitation or
Qualification, as hereafter in
its proper Place shall be said;
and sometimes it shall amount
to a Covenant. All which do
appear by the Authorities in
the Margent. *
