After fome time, my employer's wife died; The was a virtuous woman, and generally beloved of her neighbours: and foon after this, he left shopkeeping; and we parted. I then wrought at my trade, as a taylor; carefully attended meetings for worship and discipline; and found an enlargement of gospel love in my mind, and therein a concern to vifit friends in some of the back settlements of Pennfylvania and Virginia; and being thoughtful about a companion, I expressed it to my beloved friend Isaac Andrews, who then told me that he had drawings to the fame places; and also to go through Maryland, Virginia, and Carolina. After confiderable time past, and feveral conferences with him, I felt eafy to accompany him throughout;
