"We cast anchor at " cape Mizurada, but not one Negroe coming " on board, I went on shore; and being desi-" rous to be informed why they did not come " on board, was answered, That about two " months before, the English had been there " with two veffels, and had ravaged the coun-" try, destroyed all their canoes, plundered " their houses, and carried off some of their " people for flaves; upon which the re-" mainder fled to the inland country. They " tell us, they live in peace with all their " neighbours, and have no notion of any " other enemy than the English; of which " nation they had taken fome then: and " publickly declared, that they would en-65 deavour to get as many of them, as the "two mentioned ships had carried off of " their natives. These unhappy English " were in danger of being facrificed to the " the memory of their friends, which some of their nation carried off,"
