to be more lightly looked over.

Where morality is kept to, and supported by the inhabitants of a country, there is a certain reproach attends those individuals amongst them, who manifestly deviate therefrom. Thus, if a person of good report, is charged with stealing goods out of an open shop in the day time, and on a public trial found guilty, and the law in that case put in execution, he therein fustains a loss of reputation; but if he be convicted a fecond and third time of the like offence, his good name would cease amongst fuch who knew these things. If his neighbour, reputed an honest man, being charged with buying goods of this thief, at a time when the purchaser knew they were stolen, and on a public trial is found guilty, this purchaser would meet with difesteem, but if he persisted in buying stolen goods.
