Moreover, when the earth is planted and tilled, and the fruits brought forth are applied to fupport unrighteous purposes; here the gracious design of infinite goodness, in these his gifts being perverted, the earth is desiled; and the complaint formerly uttered becomes applicable; "Thou hast made me to serve with thy fins; thou hast wearied me with thine iniquities." Isaiah xliii. 24.
