

The *High Constable* may search for and teize Ropes, Winches, &c. used for unlawfull stretching the Cloaths; and if resisted, the Offender forfeits ten Pounds.

### *Customs of the King.*

**C**onstables must upon Request assist all Persons who have a lawfull Warrant to search for Goods which have not paid the Duties or Customs, and he may (if within a Month after the Offence committed) enter into any House in the Day-time; and if he is refused or resisted in making such Entry, he may *break open* the Doors.

He must likewise assist all Persons appointed by the King to collect or manage his Customs.

### *Deer-stealers.*

**T**HE Constable is to levy the Penalty by Warrant from one Justice, &c. on the Goods of Persons convicted for Deer-stealing, which is twenty Pounds for *hunting, taking, killing or wounding any Red or Fallow Deer, in any Place enclosed for keeping Deer*; and thirty Pounds for every Deer *taken, wounded or killed*; and he may detain the Offender for two Days, if he do not pay the Money, or cannot levy it, till he can make a Return of his Warrant.

He may by Virtue of a Warrant enter into any suspected Place, and carry away *Venison, Skins, of Deer or Toils*, and bring the Offender before a Justice, &c.
