*Rescues upon Seizure.*

**I**F any Person or Persons shall resist or make forcible Opposition against any of the Persons employed in the due Execution of the Acts of Parliament, 2 & 3 P. & M. 5. & 18 Eliz. 22 Car. 2. made for the more effectual Amendment of the High ways; or shall Rescue any Goods or Chattel taken in Distress, by Vertue thereof, being convicted by the Oath of one credible Witness before any one Justice of the Peace, or by the View of the Justice himself; for every such Offence the Offender shall forfeit 40 s. and if not paid in seven Days, the Party to be committed to the County Gaol, where the Offence was committed; to remain 'till paid; and this is to be delivered to the Surveyor or Surveyors of the High-ways, in the Parish where the Offence was committed, and employed for the mending the said Ways, 22 Car. 2. c. 12.

All travelling Wains, Carts, or Carriages, by way of common Carriage, are not to go with a Team on the publick High-ways, with above five Beasts at length; and if they shall drive with a greater Number of Horses or Oxen, the Offender or Owner of the Waggon, Carriage, &c, forfeits 5 l. one Moiety to the Surveyors of the High-ways of the Town, Village, or Hamlet where the Offence shall be committed, and another to the Informer; and this to be imposed on the Offender by any Justice of the Peace of the Place or Division where the Offence is committed, upon the Oath of one credible
