credible Witness, or upon the Justices own View, and to be levied by the High. Constable, or other Officer of such Place or Division, by a Warrant. And a Surveyor seeing or suffering Waggons or Carts to pass with more Horses, &c. than mentioned, or in any other Order, may, upon Conviction for such his Neglect, be amerced by the Justice in any Sum under 40 s. to be levied on his Goods and Chattels. But a Carrier may draw up-hill with as many Horses as the Sessions shall allow.
