### General Passenger Conditions

Commercial aviation, differing essentially in its element, resources, advantages and chances over older methods of transport and its regulations having not yet been established by common practice or by law, the company has drawn up the following terms and conditions which are based on reports taken from all interested parties, and which must be accepted by the passenger or his interests.

- ARTICLE 1. — Seats cannot be considered reserved until after the payment of fares and acceptance of tickets.
- ART. 2. — Should a passenger take a ticket and afterwards refuse to travel one half fare only will be refunded, the other half being retained by the Company. Should the passenger be unable to travel, owing to incidents above his control, his ticket may be transferred to the next departure, provided there is a vacancy, but the Company does not undertake to reserve the same seat on the following machine to that originally booked.
- Claims for refund cannot be considered after the expiration of three months from the time of acceptance of ticket.
- ART. 3. — The Company and or its Agents do not assume responsibility for any delay, forced landings, or interruption of journey. Nor does the Company and or its Agents undertake to refund any expenses incurred arising out of such delays, forced landings or interruptions of journey, non from any consequences which may arise therefrom.
- ART. 4. — The Company and or its agents decline all responsibility relative to accidents, loss, delay and or damage which may occur to passengers or their effects during voyages on the Company's machines, owing to storms, fogs, forced landings, changes of route or machines, strikes, leakages, fires and of all aerial disturbances arising from flying or landing. The Company and or its agents do not assume responsibility for negligence or misconduct of its Pilots or other employees or from any other cause.
- ART. 5. — Each passenger is allowed thirty pounds of free luggage, excess over this amount being charged for according to the tariffs of the various routes. Bullion, jewellery, precious objects and articles of value must be declared. Passengers are responsible for any infringement of the law in the Country in which they are.
- Passengers must not carry in their effects prohibited, exports or exports or letters. In the case of infringement of this rule the passenger is responsible for all consequences which may incur, either to himself or to the Company.
- ART. 6. — The passenger must conform to the rules laid down by the Company for the security and comfort of travellers by their machines.
- ART. 7. — No claim will be considered unless accompanied by the presentation of passenger ticket.

### Conditions Générales des Passages

Le transport aérien différant essentiellement par l'élément qu'il emprunte, les moyens auxquels il a recours, les avantages et les aléas qu'il comporte, de tous autres moyens de transport réglementés jusqu'ici, soit par la loi, soit par l'application qui a été faite en jurisprudence, les parties ont arrêté d'un commun accord les clauses et conditions suivantes qui constituent la base des rapports établis entre elles et auxquelles elles acceptent de se soumettre, soit par elles-mêmes, soit par leurs agents d'après le paiement du prix de passage et la délivrance du billet.

- ARTICLE PREMIER. — Dans le cas où, après avoir payé le prix de son passage, un voyageur renoncerait à partir, il lui serait remboursé seulement la moitié de la somme payée, l'autre moitié demeurant acquise à la Compagnie. Dans le cas où le départ serait simplement retardé par une cause fortuite, le billet pourrait être transféré à un départ suivant sans que la Compagnie soit tenue à assurer une place identique à celle primitivement réservée.
- Les demandes en remboursement du prix payé pour un passage ne sont admises que dans un délai de trois mois à compter du jour du versement.
- Ni la Compagnie, ni ses agents n'assument aucune responsabilité en cas de retard, arrêt forcé ou interruption de voyage.
- ART. 3. — La Compagnie et ses agents déclinent toute responsabilité relative à accidents, pertes, retards et interruptions de voyage, non relative aux événements de force majeure, tels que tempêtes, fogs, interruptions de service, incendies, avaries, etc.
