

their estates. And if any of the Brittish Contractors
aforesaid shall refuse to take the oaths, or to goe to the
Court you your order they may bee returned from within the
name. And for the like omission in the Contractors, and their
Assignes, the possession of their lands to bee sequestred, until
they either conforme themselves, or put of their said portion to
surety as shall be conformable in that behalf, Because they
have acquired the said lands contrary to the orders, and Writts
of the Parliament.

11 And whereas the late Commissioners sent into Ireland did, upon
their arrivall there, for the manifestation of the pleasure, and
Commandment to the Subjett, have caused the examination of
the Complaintes in the proceedings of the Parliament, enroll the
Commission, and Articles in the Chamber of the Exchequer. To
the end the same may not remaine upon records to the prejudice
of the Commandment without any beinge appearing for the
purgeation thereof. Under the seal taken for the enrollment in
the Chamber of the Exchequer in England, a full of the said
Commission, and Articles, as of the Certificates returned by
the Commissioners, and annexed to the Commission. And that
an Exemplification shall be made thereof, and transmitted into
Ireland: the pleasure is his Highnes likewise mrolled in
the Chamber, and remains of records for future times.

12 And whereas by the former Directions the portions of surety as
pertaine from persons in Ireland are stayed, and suspended
until they shall take the oaths of Supremacie as it is
contayned in the Statute 2^d Eliz. Proviso as was
then given to understand, that some Gold their portions
during life by the late Warrants. Others for good services
done to the State: And some others in service of lands
