Statistics of South Third Street.—From a supplement to Cohen's Philadelphia City Directory, for 1860, just issued, we glean the following facts in reference to the two squares of Third street, from Market to Walnutstreet, taken by the compiler:—Number of buildings therein, 83; number of bankers and brokers, 65; of Newspaper establishments 23; of job printers 13; miscellaneous 165; total number of fi ms and persons in business therein, 266; supposed number of females employed by same 4(0; number of male adults employed by same, 1866; total number of persons daily at work in the above mentioned two squares 2472, being an average of 29 to a building.
