From the Departments of Gas and Health no reports have been received.

SCHOOLS.

No report has been received from this Department. Councils are referred, for an account of their condition to the annual report. There are no public duties performed with more zeal, devotion and merit, than those connected with the direction of our Schools. The community has, however, had just reason for reproach and humiliation within the past year, over the fact that the salaries of the teachers have not been punctually paid; and that a class so eminently meritorious, have been subjected to unnecessary sacrifices and suffering.

Nothing can excuse such dereliction on the part of an affluent community. It is also to be deplored that, on account of a deficiency in the appropriation, the Night Schools, which have been eminently successful, were prematurely closed.

The income of this estate has not depreciated, its condition is satisfactory, and its management diligent and faithful. The dilapidation of years increases the expense of maintaining city property, and the expenditures incident to the repairs and renewals of the coming year may slightly effect the income. The coal lands of the city in Schaylkill county promise a large increase of income, as the period has arrived when they may be profitably presented to colliers. The necessary surveys, locations and openings are about to be made, in anticipation of their advertisement.

I have, upon a former occasion, recommended that such portions of the property of the city, which is unproductive in itself, and affords no benefit to the community, should be sold. A reference to the report of the Saparintendent of City Property, will exhibit the fact, that the wealth of the city is a heavy tax upon the city. The proceeds of unoccupied halls and rentless houses would probably realize a million of dollars, which might, with advantage to our credit, be devoted to the sinking fund.

The Railroad Securities of the City, although they have hitherto paid interest, affect the credit of the city, as swelling the apparent amount of its debts. The Corporation is not a dealer in stocks. It subscribed to these roads to secure their construction. That object attained, it is the duty of the city to withdraw the money of her citizens, especially when the protection of her own credit demands the concentration of her resources. It would be unwise to do so suddenly, or in considerable amounts; but authority might, with propriety and prudence, be conferred, that would, under the supervision of the Committee of Finance, attain the result gradually, and without affecting the value of the stock.

One of the objects primarily sought in the Act of Consolidation, was to establish in every branch of Government a system of strict accountability. All the Boards and Departments should be rigidly held responsible, and no plea of necessity, much less of convenience, should be admitted, to excuse an unauthorized expenditure of the public funds. The Councils, as the taxing power, determine the appropriations; and no Department, upon any pretext, should be allowed to exceed the amount allotted it. The countesy which sanctions such usurpations is itself an usurpation. The practice is evil and corrupt in itself, and unless checked at once will lead to evils and corruptions without limit.


The object of the Consolidation Act was to make the City and Districts an unit. The consolidation of the laws, ordinances, and rules by which they are governed. This duty is not only not fulfilled, but seems to be forgotten. Two years have elapsed since the act was was passed, and with few exceptions the old lines of the Districts are, in regard to all those ordinances which affect the daily interests of life, as distinct as before.
