Abstract

A collection of approximately four hundred autographs clipped from letters and documents that contain signatures of most of the prominent men (and seven women) in eighteenth and nineteenth-century American history. There is also a specific group of Civil War-era autographs collected from servicemen during the war.

Processing Information

The McAllister Autograph Collection was formerly interfiled within the large and chronologically-arranged McAllister Manuscript Collection. The items, which are primarily signatures clipped from letters and documents, were removed, arranged, and described as a single collection in 2005, under grants from the National Endowment for the Humanities and the William Penn Foundation. The collection was processed by Janet Koszalka and Sandra Markham. Related Collections

The Sanitary Fair Collection (McA 5781.F), McAllister Collection contains a selection of autographs that were sold at Philadelphia's Great Central Fair from the booth set up by the Relics, Curiosities, and Autographs committee. The committee collected letters, cancelled bank drafts, etc., from prominent citizens in the community, and mounted them in specially printed folders annotated with the donor's name. Because they remain in their folders, they have been kept with the Sanitary Fair Collection

Biographical/Historical Notes

Like other antiquarian collectors of the nineteenth century, John A. McAllister sought and saved autographs. His father John McAllister Jr. (1786-1877) also collected autographs along with books, pamphlets, prints, newspapers, etc. The inventory he made of his entire collection, a manuscript volume held by the Library Company of Philadelphia, lists his holdings as stored both in "albums" (numbering seven) and "loose" (550+ items). As with the other articles in his collection, John McAllister Jr. assigned the autographs to his children as part of their inheritance. Two albums were left to Agnes McAllister, and her siblings William, Sarah, John, Thomas, and Wardale were to have one each. For the loose autographs, Frances, Sarah, John, and Wardale each received one hundred, and fifty were to be received each by William, Agnes, and Thomas.

With the exception of the Civil War material in Series III, which is thought to have been assembled by John A. McAllister himself, there is no way to tell the provenance of the pieces in this collection. While it is possible that some were originally in the collection of John McAllister Jr., these autographs are primarily clipped signatures and as such have no other identifying features.

Collection Overview

The autographs in this collection are arranged in three series: Series I, Individual Signatures; Series II, Group Signatures; and Series III, Civil War Signatures.

Series I, Individual Signatures holds fragments clipped from letters, account and receipt books, bank drafts, and deeds, bonds, and other financial and legal instruments. In addition, many of the autographs of congressmen and cabinet members are simply envelopes that were saved because their signature served as franking during their terms in office. As a number of the envelopes are addressed to Edwin Stanton (1814-1869) as secretary of the War Department (a post he held from 1862 to 1868), it is likely that John A. McAllister either had a friend working in that office, or acquired a trove of discarded envelopes through another means. The McAllister Collection, however, does not hold the letters that had been enclosed in the envelopes. Additional envelopes (without notable autographs) are filed in Series III.

With a few exceptions, the autographs are not annotated to identify the signature; one exception is for Anton Probst (1842-1866), on which someone wrote "autograph of Probst the Murderer." Probst axed to death of six members of the Dearing family, their farm hand, and a family guest, on April 7, 1866. In the case of artist Thomas Sully (1783-1872), his folder holds both a clipped autograph and a calling card on which a facsimile of his signature was engraved. Another interesting item is the autograph of naval commodore Thomas ap Catesby Jones (1790-1858) of Georgetown, which is on a promissory note dated 1833. The verso of the note is annotated in red ink: "Taken from the/residence of T. Ap/Catesby Jones by/Dr. W.T.W. Dickeson/Surg 4th Pa Res. Vol/October 1861," and as such marks it as an item collected for John A. McAllister.

Most of the men and women listed have single signatures in their folders, but if more than one appears, it is indicated in the box and folder list. Occasionally there are multiple signatures; for example, there are a dozen for Samuel Delucenna Ingham.

<u>Series II, Group Signatures</u> holds ten fragments of paper which were signed by several people on each piece. These were clipped from documents such as petitions and legal documents and probably were meant to be further cut down. In one case, individual signatures had already been clipped out of the group. The individual signers in each group are listed.

Series III, Civil War Signatures is arranged in two subseries: Autograph Album; and Clipped Signatures. The first is not an actual bound album, but is a collection of nineteen sheets of ordinary lined paper blind-stamped with "E.H. OWEN," each of which holds four or fewer signatures of military men, with their rank, unit, and home town. It is not known who compiled the pages, but if it was John A. McAllister, who did not serve in the military, the signatures might possibly have been those of servicemen who passed through the Cooper Shop or Union volunteer refreshment saloons in Philadelphia, or were patients in one of the local army hospitals.

The second subseries holds fragments that were cut from orders, correspondence, and other official military documents, and were formerly mounted in an album of Civil War ephemera (which was disbound prior to 2005). They are housed alphabetically by signer in five folders; surnames appear in the box and folder list following. Many of the fragments were annotated on their verso in red ink with the officer's name and rank.
