

Series II, Documents (1812-1837) holds a dozen letters of attorney, three promissory notes, an undated manuscript list of bank directors, and a group of stock certificates issued between 1814 and 1834. The final folder contains receipts issued to some of the bank's earliest shareholders, certifying installment payments on "Capital Stock of the State Bank at Camden, Subject to the law establishing State Banks, in New-Jersey" dated March 1812, and signed by four commissioners: Joseph Cooper, Joseph Rogers, Azel Pierson, and Joseph Sloan.
