

pay into the Hands of the Treasurer the Sum of *Five Shillings* (for the Use of the Library as aforesaid) and not be obliged either to pay or serve for the Space of four Years then next ensuing; and also that when any one of us the Subscribers aforesaid, shall be chosen Clerk for the said Company, and refuse to serve, such Member so refusing, shall forfeit and pay as aforesaid, the Sum of *Five Shillings*, and not be obliged either to pay or serve until the whole Company have either served as Clerks to the Company, or paid as aforesaid: And further, that when any of us are by Virtue of these Presents chosen, and he accept the Office, shall be true and faithful in the Exercise of his Function and in the Discharge of the Trust committed to him, every one according to the Nature and Duty of his Office: But more especially in Preserving to the utmost of his Power unto every one of the Subscribers in Company aforesaid his just Right and Property in and to the said Books and Effects in common, under the Order and Rule, and subject to the Limitations and Restrictions in and by these Presents established, limited and declared.
