

IV. Every member or other person who shall neglect to return the book or books, within the time specified in his note, shall pay to the Librarian for such neglect, for the use of the Library, two pence per day, or for each time the Library is afterwards opened for letting out books; and if not returned within one month from the expiration of the time limited in the note, and all fines accruing paid off the note or deposit money; shall be deemed forfeited to the Company.

V. Books returned are to be delivered into the hands of the Librarian to be examined whether damaged or not.

VI. No person from whom any hire or forfeiture is due, or who hath damaged any book, shall be permitted to have another book till satisfaction be made.

VII. If it should happen that a *Member*, and one who *is not a Member* should apply for the same book at the same time, the Member shall have the preference.

VIII. A Member may take out on hire, without a deposit, as many books in value, for which his share shall, by the Librarian, be deemed, a sufficient security, on the same terms in other respects, as persons who are not members.

IX. The Librarian, from his book of entries, shall make out a list of forfeitures which have arisen, in a book to be kept for that purpose; and on the first Monday in every month, he shall deliver to the Secretary, a copy of the same to be laid before the Directors, at their usual Meetings.
