



At an election held at the Library Rooms
for ten directors & a treasurer on the 3^d day of
May (being the first Monday) 1790 -

William Craig Esquire & Josiah L.
Coates were duly appointed Judges to
assist the Secretary in conducting the
election agreeably to the Charter & Laws
of the institution.

Witness my hand this 3^d day of
May 1790. *(Signature)* Secretary.

We certify that at the election held on the 3^d
day of May 1790 - the same being the first
Monday in the said month the following
persons were elected Directors and Treasurer
for the ensuing year viz.

Josiah Newes, Joseph Paschall, John
Kaighn, Thomas Morris, Thomas Parke
Abnerai Lewis, Richard Wells,
Benjamin Poultney, Richard Wister,
Benjamin Gibbs, Directors and Samuel
Coates, Treasurer, each of whom had
forty four votes - Witness our hands this
third day of May 1790 -
