



The Secretary reports that he attended the meeting of the members of the Library Company of Pennsylvania convened in the Library Room on Saturday the 27th of November last in pursuance of the request of a number of the members and after public notice given in the newspapers of this City in conformity to a bye law of the 3.^d of May 1742 for the purpose of taking into consideration the propriety of having the Library open during the whole day at which William Rawle Esquire in pursuance of the request of the Directors presided & the following Resolutions were moved & seconded

1st Resolved As the opinion of this meeting That it would tend to promote the interests of Literature as well as of this Institution that the Library be in future kept open during the morning as well as the afternoon

2.^d Resolved As the opinion of this meeting That the Library ought to be so kept open as soon as its funds shall be found adequate thereto

On taking the question
Thirty six attending members and five absent members represented by proxies voted in the affirmative and Seventy one attending members
