to examine the accounts of the Treasurers and
Librarians report that they had performed that
duty and found the same to be correct show-
ing a balance in the Treasurers hands of
 $1375 \frac{6}{100}$ dollars and a balance due the Librarian
of $44 \frac{39}{100}$ dollars. The amount of the building
fund is $15,596 \frac{78}{100}$ dollars of which $15,371 \frac{82}{100}$
is invested in City 6' & U.S. loan and the
balance of $224 \frac{96}{100}$ is on deposit in the Pa
Life Insurance & Trust Co.

The committee also reported that
they had examined the assets and securities
in the Treasurers hands & found them correct.

The Secretary reported and read the returns of the
Election for Directors and Treasurer of the Company
held on the 4. day of May 1863 showing that Lewis
Wade, George W. Smith, Henry J. Williams, Charles
Pilling, J. Pemberton Hutchinson, David Lewis,
J. S. Clark Hare, Peter McCall, Alexander Piddle
and Henry Wharton were elected Directors and Lloyd
P. Smith Treasurer for the ensuing year.
Wm. S. Whitman was appointed Secy.
