

Librarian's Report Oct 2^d 1879

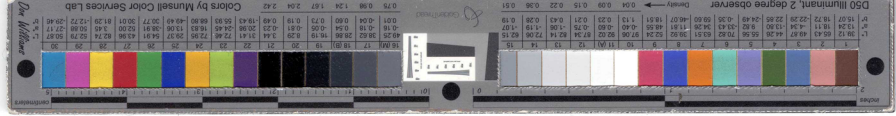
Lawrence Coxe, our second Assistant, has left the service of the Library. I respectfully request permission to take another young man on trial, Edward Parker at \$3. - a week.

I suggest that the time has nearly come to appoint a Janitor for the Locust St Building.

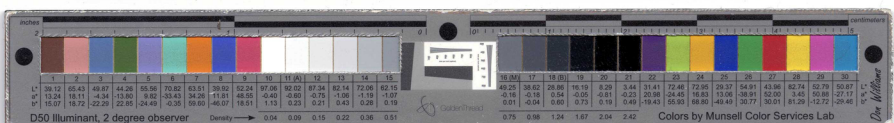
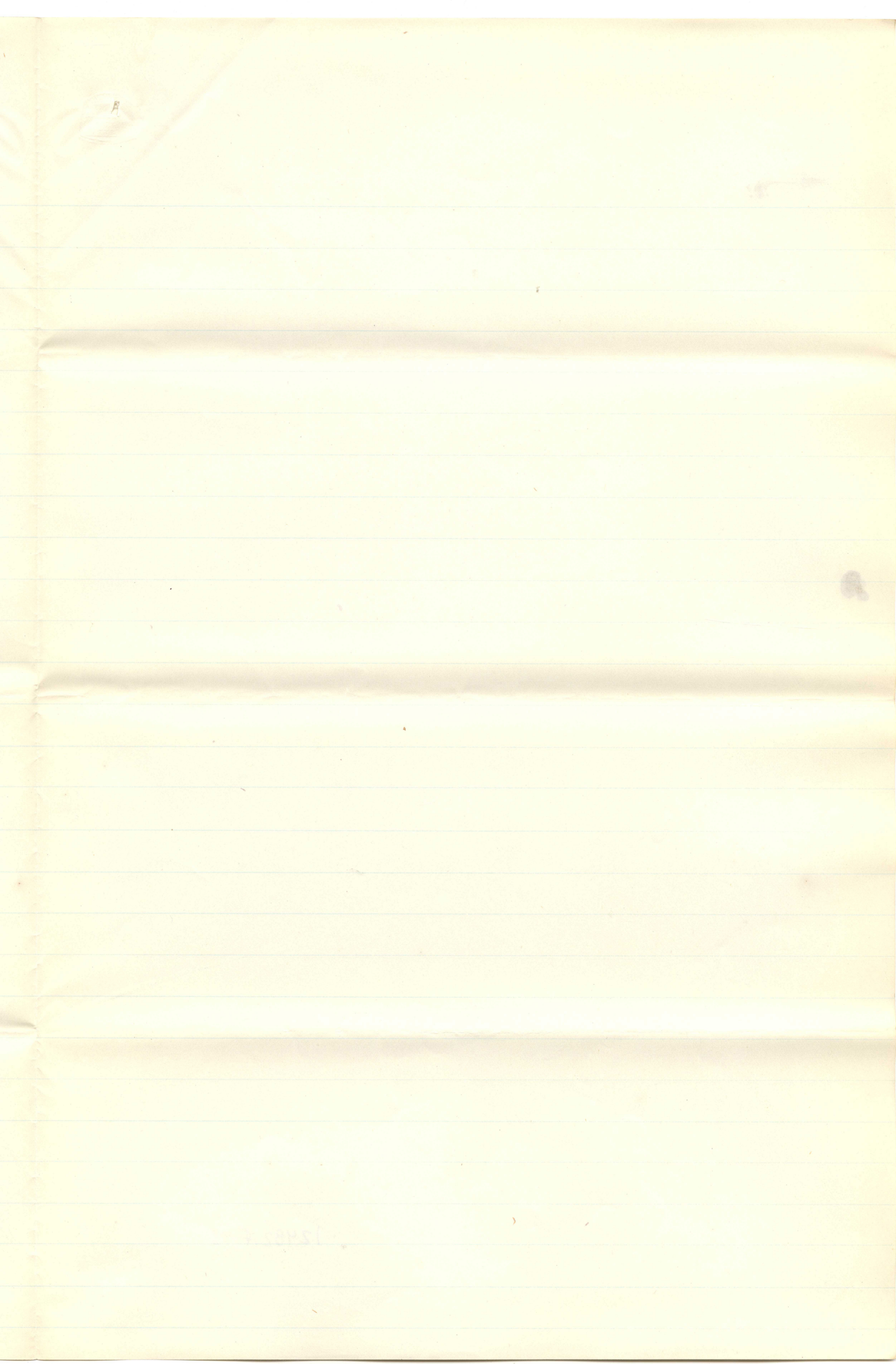

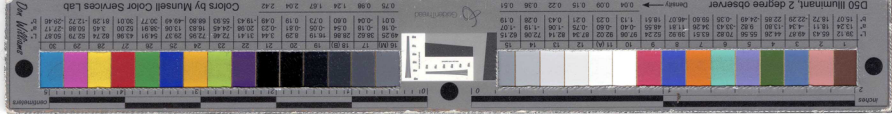
The number of visitors at the Ridway Branch during September was	1254

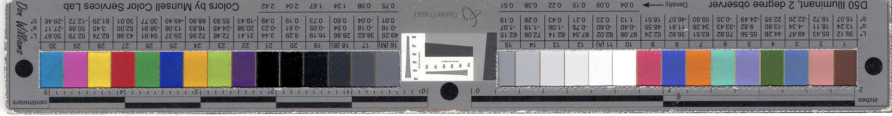

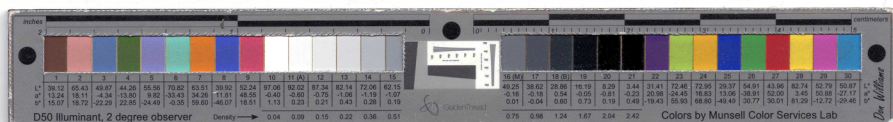

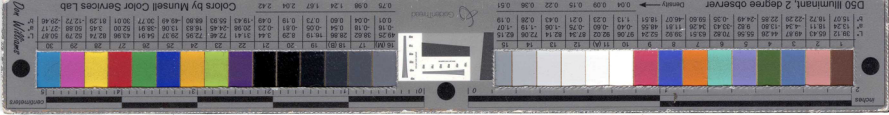
