Librarian's Report

Since the Ridgway Branch has been opened a number of books and pamphlets of small value have been presented to that Institution from time to time, of which an exact record has been made in the Accessions Catalogue. During the past month two presents have been rec^d of considerable value. One is a copy in 5 vols folio of the Corpus juris civilis cum glossis. Lyons 1550. from Pompton Cox. The other is a collection of bound newspapers and other works about 100 vols in all, and about 50 maps and charts, from Mr John A. McAllister.

The attendance at the Locust St Library during the past month is the largest in the history of the Library being 10837 or a daily average of 401. The highest in any previous month was Feb 1881 being a daily average of 375. The figures for March are as follows:
