The Committee appointed at the last meeting to examine the Treasurer's & Librarian's accounts reports that they have performed that duty & find the same correct - The Balance due the Building Fund is \$1825.46 - due May 6th \$1732.94 and due Librarian \$125.65.

The Treasurer reports that the President of the Mercantile Library called to inform him that they had been threatened by the Collector of Delinquent Taxes with a suit for the taxes of the past three years.
