In looking over the ex-
pense side of our accounts the Committee
find that the aggregate of Salaries paid
amounts to \$7494.00, exclusive of Dr.
Mumwell's pay which seems to have
been temporary. The Committee feel
that they ought to call the attention of
the Board to the large ratio (32.1 per
cent) which Salaries bear to the total
of income, and to suggest whether it
may not be advisable to rearrange
the whole Schedule of Salaries with a
view to greater economy.

The large out-
standing bill for binding the books of the A-
frican Library ought, we think, to receive the
attention of the Board as Librarian Trustees.
